**Reason for request:** The Pape family held a significant amount of agricultural land bordering Nacogdoches Road from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century to the 1930's. The National Register's nomination for the Historic Farms and Ranches of Bexar County, Texas, noted that the period significance between 1880 and 1920 recounts the second major influx of European immigrants within the local populace and an attendant increase in the numbers of First- and Second-generation Americans, vast improvements to transportation routes and consequent trade expansion, and overall growth of agricultural production, which is certainly illustrated by this German family farm. More recently, the El Camino Real signs were installed in the neighborhood.


**General Location:** Between Woodbury Dr. and Worldland within City Council District 10
