The seminar will introduce critical concepts of the 2024 International Existing Building Code® (IEBC®). It will provide a basis for the correct use and application of the code through detailing basic tables, categorizations, and a case study. Learning objectives include:

- Recognize limitation and extent of the codes related to existing buildings.
- recognize the classifications of work associated with existing buildings.
- Identify fire protection systems that need to be upgraded.
- Recognize vertical openings that need partial or complete enclosure.
- Identify unsafe interior finishes that need to be replaced.
- Determine adequate means of egress.
- Identify needed accessibility improvements.
- Identify improvements to structural systems.
- Describe the compliance alternative tabular method of evaluating existing buildings.
