## HOW TO REPORT GRAFFITI

There are 3 easy ways to report graffiti seen on private and public property. You can:

- Call 3-1-1
- Download the 311 App
- Report it online at SA.Gov/311



What you should do if you see tagging:

- Report it through 3-1-1
- Record pictures for home insurance or police report
- Remove graffiti from your property within 24-48 hours

### FREE PAINT DISPOSAL

Dispose properly of household hazardous waste (HHW), such as:

- oil
- paint
- pesticides
- anti-freeze
- batteries
- household cleaners

The HHW sites are free for City of San Antonio solid waste customers who pay an environmental fee (that appears on your CPS Energy bill). You must show proof of fee payment, along with a picture ID to use this service. Additional details can be found through the QR code.

### Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design



Natural Access Control is the use of elements like doors, shrubs, fences and gates to create barriers that are seen as a risk to vandals.

**Natural Surveillance** occurs by designing the placement of features, activities, and people as a way to maximize visibility and create proper use of public and private spaces.

**Territorial Reinforcement** relates to creating a more defined space. When people take pride in what they own and protect their belongings, crime is lowered because it's more challenging.

Contact your local nursery for recommended species. All designs must be in accordance with City Codes.

### DECREASE GRAFFITI, IMPROVE SAFETY

- Use a locking gate between your front and back yard.
- Remove design features that give access to roofs.
- Focus on lighting. Well lit areas are deterrents to crime.
- Make your address visible from the street.
- · Plant more trees in residential areas.
- · Use low, thorny bushes beneath windows.

Community service vouchers are available upon request. Scan the QR code to sign up.




#### **Graffiti Educational Presentations**
